#### 1st Joyful Mystery - The Annunciation (Luk 1:26-27)

In the sixth month, the angel Gabriel was sent from God to a city of Galilee named Nazareth, to a virgin betrothed to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David; and the virgin's name was Mary.

Fruit of the Mystery - Humility

#### 2nd Joyful Mystery - The Visitation (Luk 1:39-42)

In those days Mary arose and went with haste into the hill country, to a city of Judah, and she entered the house of Zechariah and greeted Elizabeth. And when Elizabeth heard the greeting of Mary, the babe leaped in her womb; and Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit and she exclaimed with a loud cry, "Blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb!" **Fruit of the Mystery - Love of Neighbor** 

#### 3rd Joyful Mystery - The Nativity (Luk 2:1-7)

In those days a decree went out from Caesar Augustus that all the world should be enrolled. This was the first enrollment, when Quirinius was governor of Syria. And all went to be enrolled, each to his own city. And Joseph also went up from Galilee, from the city of Nazareth, to Judea, to the city of David, which is called Bethlehem, because he was of the house and lineage of David, to be enrolled with Mary, his betrothed, who was with child. And while they were there, the time came for her to be delivered. And she gave birth to her first-born son and wrapped him in swaddling cloths, and laid him in a manger, because there was no place for them in the inn.

Fruit of the Mystery - Poverty

#### 4th Joyful Mystery - The Presentation in the Temple (<u>Luk 2:21-24</u>)

And at the end of eight days, when he was circumcised, he was called Jesus, the name given by the angel before he was conceived in the womb. And when the time came for their purification according to the law of Moses, they brought him up to Jerusalem to present him to the Lord (as it is written in the law of the Lord, 'Every male that opens the womb shall be called holy to the Lord') and to offer a sacrifice according to what is said in the law of the Lord, 'a pair of turtledoves, or two young pigeons.'

Fruit of the Mystery - Purity of Heart and Body

#### 5th Joyful Mystery - The Finding in the Temple (Luk 2:41-47)

Now his parents went to Jerusalem every year at the feast of the Passover. And when he was twelve years old, they went up according to custom; and when the feast was ended, as they were returning, the boy Jesus stayed behind in Jerusalem. His parents did not know it. After three days they found him in the temple, sitting among the teachers, listening to them and asking them questions; and all who heard him were amazed at his understanding and his answers.

Fruit of the Mystery - Devotion to Jesus

### 1st Luminous Mystery - The Baptism of Christ in the Jordan (Mat 3:16-17)

And when Jesus was baptized, he went up immediately from the water, and behold, the heavens were opened and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and alighting on him; and lo, a voice from heaven, saying, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well-pleased." **Fruit of the Mystery - Openness To The Holy Spirit** 

### 2nd Luminous Mystery - The Wedding Feast at Cana (Jn 2:1-5)

On the third day there was a marriage at Cana in Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there; Jesus also was invited to the marriage, with his disciples. When the wine failed, the mother of Jesus said to him, "They have no wine." And Jesus said to her, "O woman, what have you to do with me? My hour has not yet come." His mother said to the servants, "Do whatever he tells you." **Fruit of the Mystery - To Jesus Through Mary** 

## 3rd Luminous Mystery - Jesus' Proclamation of the Coming of the Kingdom of God (Mar 1:15)

The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand; repent, and believe in the gospel. **Fruit of the Mystery - Conversion** 

## 4th Luminous Mystery - The Transfiguration (Mat 17:1-2)

And after six days Jesus took with him Peter and James and John his brother, and led them up a high mountain apart. And he was transfigured before them, and his face shone like the sun, and his garments became white as light.

Fruit of the Mystery - Desire for Holiness

### 5th Luminous Mystery - The Institution of the Eucharist (Mat 26:26)

Now as they were eating, Jesus took bread, and blessed, and broke it, and gave it to the disciples and said, 'Take, eat; this is my body."

Fruit of the Mystery - Adoration

## 1st Sorrowful Mystery - The Agony in the Garden (Mat 26:36-39)

Then Jesus went with them to a place called Gethsemane, and he said to his disciples, "Sit here, while I go yonder and pray." And taking with him Peter and the two sons of Zebedee, he began to be sorrowful and troubled. Then he said to them, "My soul is very sorrowful, even to death; remain here, and watch with me." And going a little farther he fell on his face and prayed, "My Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me; nevertheless, not as I will, but as you will."

Fruit of the Mystery - Obedience to God's Will

### 2nd Sorrowful Mystery - The Scourging at the Pillar (Mat 27:26)

Pilate released Barabbas to them, but after he had Jesus scourged, he handed him over to be crucified.

Fruit of the Mystery - Mortification

## 3rd Sorrowful Mystery - The Crowning With Thorns (Mat 27:27-29)

Then the soldiers of the governor took Jesus into the praetorium, and they gathered the whole battalion before him. And they stripped him and put a scarlet robe upon him, and plaiting a crown of thorns they put it on his head, and put a reed in his right hand. And kneeling before him they mocked him, saying, "Hail, King of the Jews!"

Fruit of the Mystery - Courage

### 4th Sorrowful Mystery - The Carrying of the Cross (Mar 15:21-22)

And they compelled a passer-by, Simon of Cyrene, who was coming in from the country, the father of Alexander and Rufus, to carry his cross. And they brought him to the place called Golgotha (which means the place of a skull).

Fruit of the Mystery - Patience

### 5th Sorrowful Mystery - The Crucifixion and Death (Luk 23:33-46)

And when they came to the place which is called The Skull, there, they crucified him and the criminals, one on the right and one on the left. And Jesus said, "Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do." It was now about the sixth hour, and there was darkness over the whole land until the ninth hour, while the sun's light failed; and the curtain of the temple was torn in two. Then Jesus, crying with a loud voice, said, "Father, into thy hands I commit my spirit!" And having said this, he breathed his last.

# Fruit of the Mystery - Sorrow for our Sins

#### 1st Glorious Mystery - The Resurrection (Luk 24:1-5)

But on the first day of the week, at early dawn, they went to the tomb, taking the spices which they had prepared. And they found the stone rolled away from the tomb, but when they went in, they did not find the body. While they were perplexed about this, behold, two men stood by them in dazzling apparel; and as they were frightened and bowed their faces to the ground, the men said to them, "Why do you seek the living among the dead? He is not here, but has risen."

Fruit of the Mystery - Faith

#### 2nd Glorious Mystery - The Ascension (Mar 16:19)

So then the Lord Jesus, after he had spoken to them, was taken up into heaven, and sat down at the right hand of God.

Fruit of the Mystery - Hope

### **3rd Glorious Mystery - Descent of the Holy Spirit** (Act 2:1-4)

When the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place. And suddenly a sound came from heaven like the rush of a mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting. And there appeared to them tongues as of fire, distributed and resting on each one of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

Fruit of the Mystery - Wisdom

#### 4th Glorious Mystery - The Assumption (Luk 1:48-49)

Henceforth all generations will call me blessed; for he who is mighty has done great things for me. **Fruit of the Mystery - Devotion to Mary** 

## 5th Glorious Mystery - The Coronation of Mary (Rev 12:1)

And a great portent appeared in heaven, a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars.

Fruit of the Mystery - Grace of a Happy Death
